Groups are open to children of all abilities. Participants will be screened prior to confirming enrollment. Eligible participants will be grouped by age and skill level.

► Virtual Circle Time

- Open to all children 6 years of age and under and their siblings
- Program suitable for children with Down Syndrome, ASD and developmental disabilities.
- Parent/caregiver support recommended
- Program runs Mondays and Thursdays from 11:15 AM – 11:45 AM

► Brief Description:

- Children will participate in a fun and engaging circle time.
- Program will focus on early language development, imitation skills and play. Parents will be provided with coaching throughout the session to help support their child with each activity.

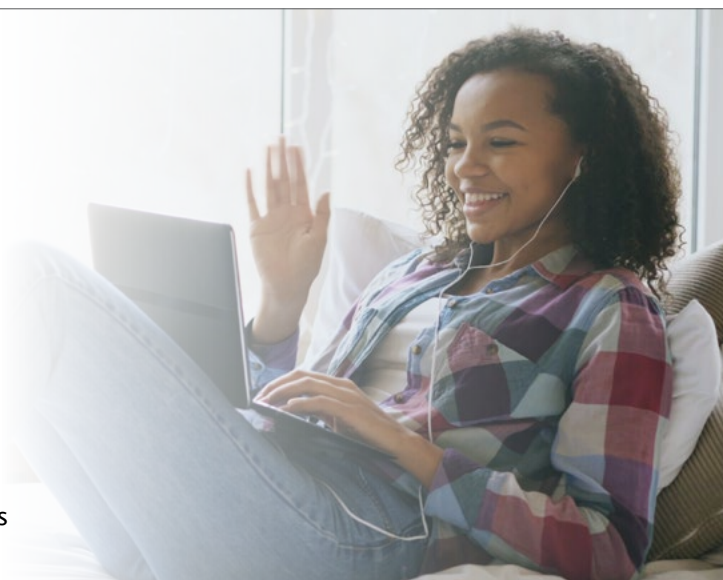
TEEN GROUP

► Stay Connected Teen Social Group

- Open to teens with ASD and/or developmental disabilities, 12–16 years of age
- Program runs Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4:30 PM – 5:30 PM

► Brief Description:

- Participants will engage in interactive activities and games while connecting with peers.
- Program will focus on the social connections, developing shared interests and building relationships
